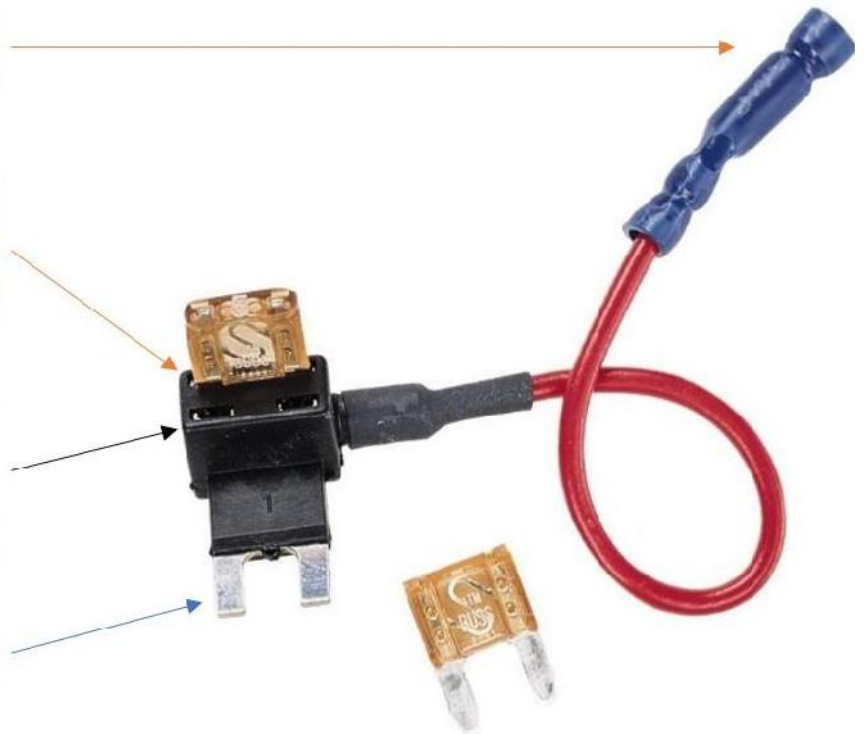


This is the output for the power tap. The blue connector is a butt connector used for crimping

This fuse is what powers the hard-wire tap (i.e. it protects the output wire)
TIP: This is the fuse socket farther away from the fuse box, hence it closes the tapped circuit

If the fuse box already had a fuse in the socket, that original fuse goes into this.
TIP: This is the fuse socket closer to the fuse box, hence it closes the original circuit

This plugs into the fuse box



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
