

Quick setup guide Falcon Navigator

Lets get started

Press the button on top of the unit for a couple of seconds to switch it on. The unit will automatically start up your navigation.

You will see a screen confirming the vehicle and sizes. (This is a default screen and will change after you have set your vehicle profile up)

Press **DONE** and then you can start the process of personalising your Sat Nav.

What do I do if my unit says "Please set Navigation Path"?

Press the OK button on the message until it disappears from the screen.

Press the **NAVI PATH** icon

Press the small box on the right that show three lines and three dots

you will see a file named **SDMMC** press on this and then you will see **NAVI.EXE**

Press **NAVI.EXE** until it is ticked and press **OK**. Go back to the first screen and press the **Navigation** icon.

Setting up your vehicle dimensions

NB: The default size setting is in feet if you wish to enter your details in metres then you will need to follow this steps below first

On the main screen select **MORE** Then **SETTINGS** and scroll down to

REGIONAL - UNITS AND FORMATS - DISTANCE

When pressing **DISTANCE** it allows you to switch between meters and feet. Make you selection and continue.

On the main screen select **MORE - SETTINGS** and scroll down to **ROUTE SETTINGS**

The vehicle field at the top will tell you which type of vehicle it is currently set to use, eg. Motorhome, Car and Caravan, or Car

Tap the vehicle field button

You will see a list of vehicles you can choose from

To change the settings for any of the vehicles select the tools icon (spanner and screwdriver) next to the relevant entry, you can then enter your vehicle dimensions, lenghth, weight, etc. and tick if you are towing.

When the details have been entered then make sure the **black spot** is selected next to the relevant vehicle

How to Find an address by Postcode or Town and Street Name

On the main screen press

FIND - FIND ADDRESS - TOWN

You now have an option to enter a **TOWN** or **POSTCODE**

When entering a Postcode you must enter the space

for example: WA4 4LE

or just enter a town and street name

Press RESULTS then Press SELECT TOWN

You will now see your destination on a map

You can move the cursor around on the map Allowing you to pinpoint a specific area

When you are happy with the details entered

Press NEXT - NEW ROUTE - GO

The sat nav's preferred route for your vehicle will now be displayed, at this point you can look for

ROUTE ALTERNATIVES

Press MORE - ROUTE ALTERNATIVES

How to find your Campsites and Points of Interest

On the main screen press

FIND - FIND PLACES - CUSTOM SEARCH

Select one of the four options presented

This allows you to search the information in your chosen area

All your information will be shown in separate categories

Press on the file you require eg. Aires, Campsites, LPG etc.

Now press the selected entry that you want to travel to

Press NEXT - NEW ROUTE - GO

Alternatively

If you know the name of the place you want to find then use **FIND BY NAME** in the bottom right hand corner.

Type in the name and you will see RESULTS in the bottom right. When you have selected the place you want to visit

Press NEXT - NEW ROUTE - GO

How to enter Co-ordinates

On the main screen press

FIND - MORE

You will find this at the centre bottom of the screen

Enter your longitude and latitude

There are three options

Press - MORE - UNITS & FORMATS

Select - New Route

How to Create a Route

On the main screen press

MY ROUTE - CREATE A ROUTE

If this is not highlighted press **CANCEL ROUTE** first then press the **+** button

You can now search for places using all the finding places options

You can now add as many Waypoints as you wish

When you have finished inputting your data press GO

You can now look at **ROUTE ALTERNATIVES**, **ITINERARY** or **SAVE ROUTE** by pressing the **MORE** button

How to Save a Route

Once you have created a route, you can save it for future reference, here's how to do it

Go to MY ROUTE - OVERVIEW - MORE

Scroll down to SAVE ROUTE

You can now name the route of your choice and this will be stored after pressing **DONE**

To retrieve your route at a later stage

Go to MY ROUTE - OVERVIEW - MORE

Scroll down to LOAD ROUTE

Press BACK until you are at **SHOW MAP** and your route will be operating

<u>Avoidances</u>

Should you wish to avoid a specific road along your journey or simply the road ahead

MY ROUTE - AVOIDANCES you now have an option to choose

AVOID ROAD AHEAD or AVOID SPECIFIC ROAD

The Navigator will re-calculate and you can accept or return to your original route

Speed cameras

You can adjust the notifications on the speed cameras

Press MORE - SOUNDS AND WARNINGS

SPEED CAMERA & ALERT POINT SETTINGS

If you untick the box this will **switch off all** notifications

If you select ALERT TYPES

this allows you to adjust separate camera alerts to visual, audible or disable

Advance Warning of Junctions & Exits

You can adjust the notification given for junctions and exits by going to:

MORE - SETTINGS - SOUNDS AND WARNING WARNING SIGN ALERTS

By clicking on the individual options Lanes and Overtaking etc.

It allows to increase or decrease the distance for notification

Powering the Navigator

Two power leads are included, a mains adapter and a cigarette lighter adapter that can be used on 12V or 24V vehicles.

Please note that you cannot charge your Navigator via the included USB cable, this is for connecting to a computer for updating maps, adding music etc.

Only the included adapters should be used, adapters and cables from other devices may not be able to provide enough power to run the device properly.

Turning the Navigator off

To power the Navigator off first exit the Navigation app by using the power icon in the bottom left corner of the main screen. Now press the power button on the top of the Navigator for 2 seconds and select the shut icon on the screen.

If you turn off your vehicle ignition or disconnect the Navigator while it is running you will get a warning that it is continuing on battery power.


If you are intending to be away from power for more than 30 minutes or you get low power warnings then you should turn the Navigator off as described above.

Screen Calibration

If you ever find that touches on the screen are not registering precisely you can re-calibrate the screen by selecting the "Calibration" icon from the main menu.

When it asks if you are sure you wish to calibrate select Yes and you will then see the following screen:



Using the stylus* carefully select the center of the cross and repeat as the cross moves from the center, to each corner of the screen in turn then click anywhere on the screen to return to the main menu.

^{*}The stylus is located in the rear of the sat nav (5" units) or on the back of the mounting plate (7" units)

How do I change the Voice on the Navigator?

Press MORE-SETTINGS-SOUNDS AND WARNINGS VOICE LANGUAGE

What next?
