First Time Installation

Connecting a TV aerial or satellite dish to your TV

To use with a satellite dish (for Freesat or other DVB-S/S2 channels)

Connect your dish to the TV's input marked "ANT 1 DVB-S/S2".

ANT 1
DVB-S/S2

To use with an aerial (for Freeview, Saorview etc. or other DVB-T2 channels)

Connect a TV Aerial to the TV's input marked "ANT 2 DVB-T2/C".

ANT 2
DVB-T2/C

First Time Installation

When you first turn your TV on you will see the First Time Installation screen, you can also start the first time installation procedure by pressing the menu button and using the ◀ / ▶ buttons to move to the setup menu and then use the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select "First Time Installation" and press OK.

Select Language

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select the language to be used for menus and messages.

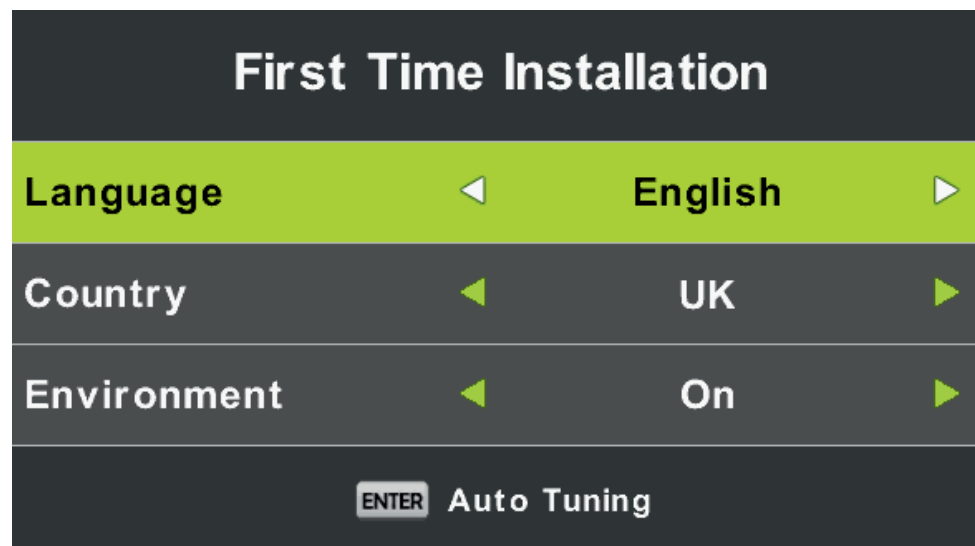
Select Country

Press ▼ / ▲ button to highlight country menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select the country you are in.

Press the OK button.

For low power mode leave the Environment setting On



To use with a satellite dish (DVB-S2 eg. Freesat.)

Press ◀ / ▶ button to set the Digital Type to **Satellite**

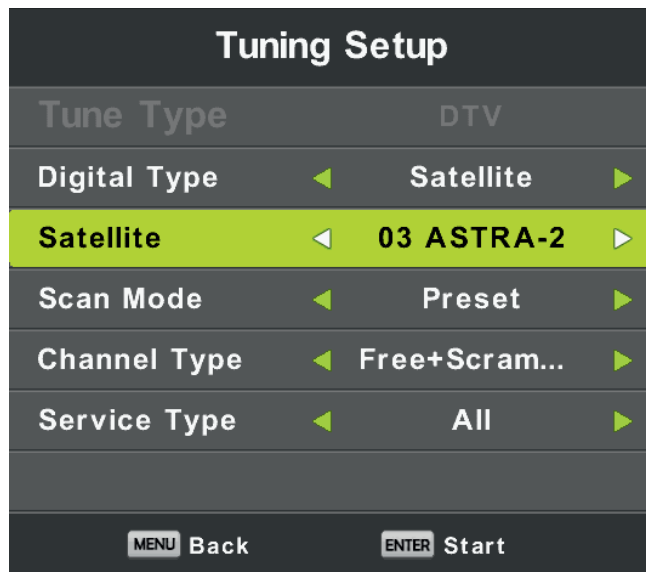
Press ▼ / ▲ button to highlight satellite menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select the satellite to use, eg. 03 ASTRA-2 for the UK Freesat service.

Press the OK button.

When you see the message “Do you want to use preset channel list” press the left arrow button to confirm.

Wait a few seconds for the Database Imported Successfully message and then the TV enters viewing mode.

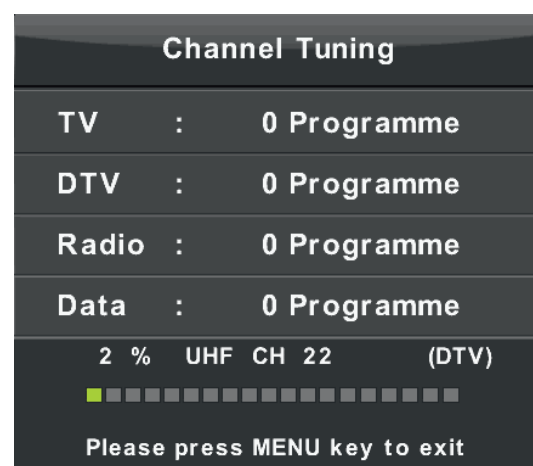
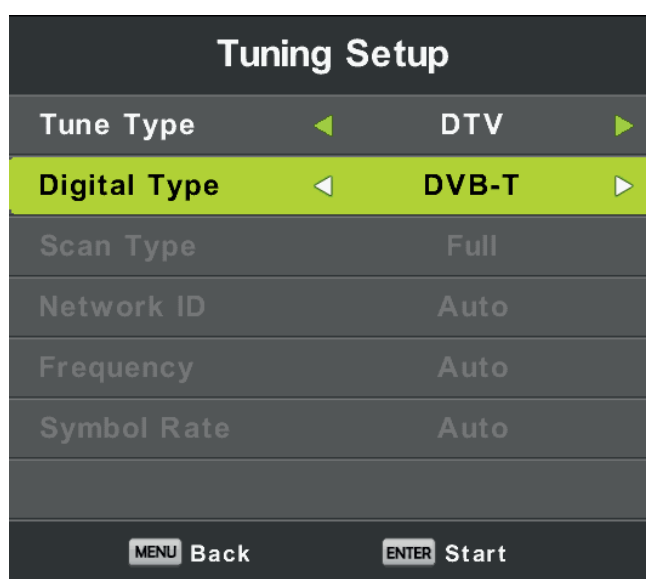


To use with an aerial (DVB-T2 eg. Freeview, Saorview etc.)

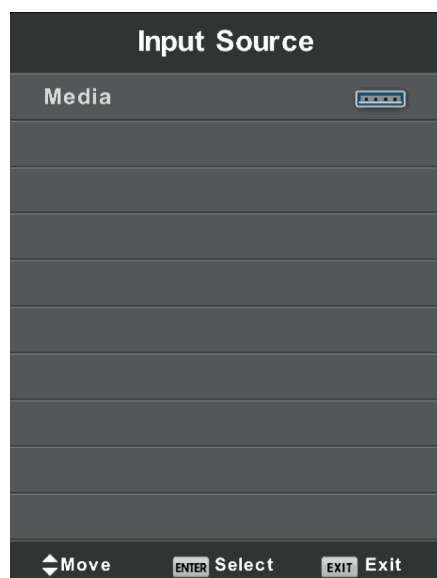
Press ◀ / ▶ button to set the Digital Type to **DVB-T**

Press the OK button to begin auto tuning.

Wait for tuning to finish and then the TV enters viewing mode.



SELECT INPUT SOURCE



Press the **INPUT** button to display the input source list,

Press **▼ / ▲** or **OK** button to select the input source you want,

Press **OK** button to enter the input source or press the **EXIT** button to quit.

The available inputs are:

Satellite: For use with a satellite dish (DVB-S2 eg. Freesat.)

DTV: Digital TV with an aerial (DVB-T2 eg. Freeview, Saorview etc.)

ATV: Analogue TV with an aerial.

AV: For connection of a composite video and audio signal to the Mini AV socket.

PC: For connection of a computer to the VGA socket.

SCART: For connection of a device to the SCART socket.

Component: For connection of a component video signal to the Mini Y/Pb/Pr socket.

DVD: For playing a DVD or CD using the built in DVD player.

HDMI1: For the HDMI socket on the rear of the TV at the bottom.

HDMI2: For the HDMI socket on the side of the TV.

Media: For playback of media connection to the USB socket on the side of the TV.

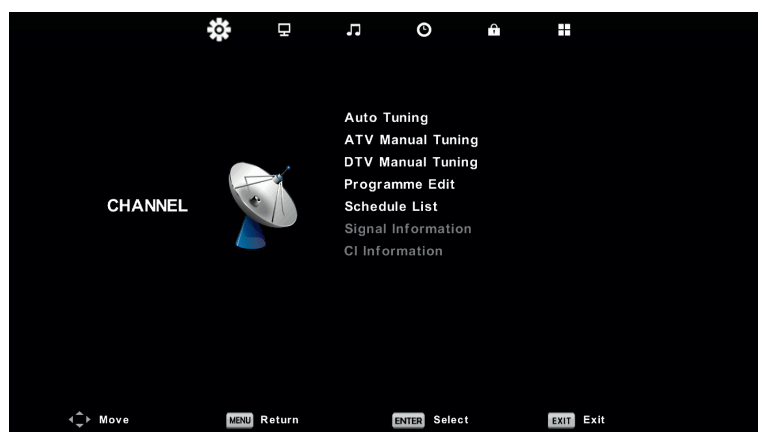
Main Menu Operation

Channel Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **CHANNEL** in the main menu.

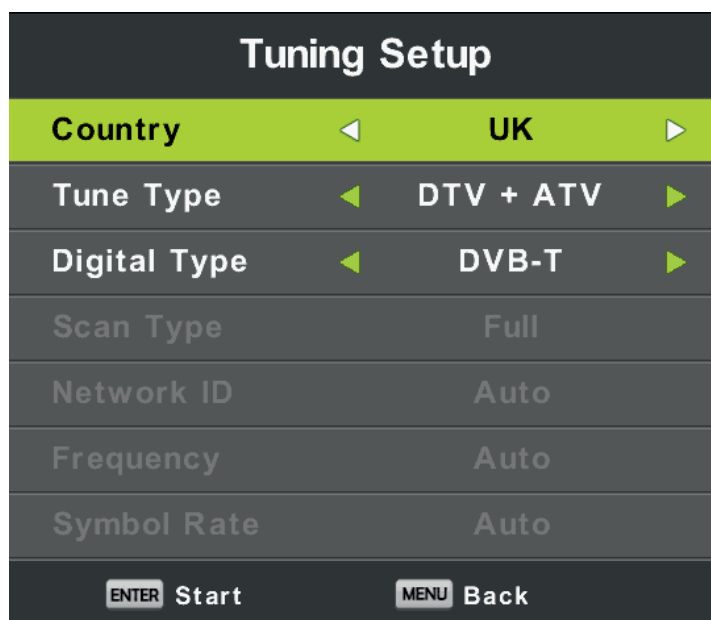
In DTV Source.



1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to highlight the option that you want to adjust in the **CHANNEL** menu.
2. Press **OK** button to select the highlighted option.
3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **Menu** button to save and return to the previous menu.

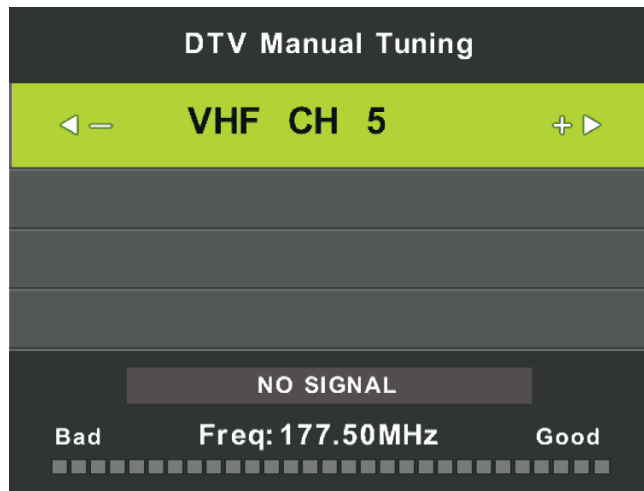
Auto Tuning

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Auto Tuning, then press **OK** button to enter.



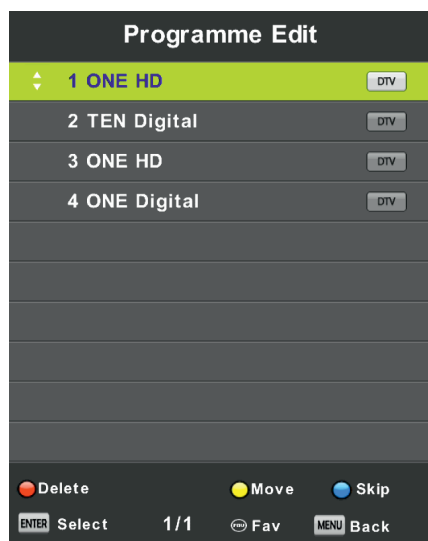
DTV Manual Tuning

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select DTV Manual Tuning, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select channel, then press **OK** button to search program.



Program Edit (reordering the channel list)

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Program Edit, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.



The three colored keys are shortcut keys for programming the channel.

First press ▼ / ▲ to highlight the channel you want to select, then:

Press the **Red** button to delete the program in the list.

Press the **Yellow** button to move the channel in favorite list.

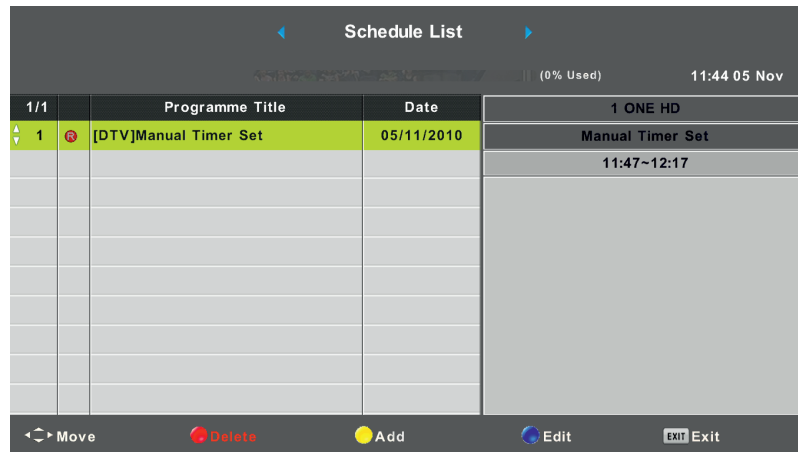
Press the **Blue** button to skip the selected channel.

Press Fav button to add or remote the channel to your favorite list.

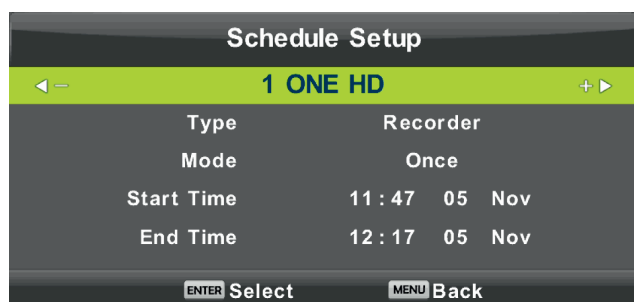
(Your TV set will skip between these channels automatically when using CH+/- to view the channels.)

Schedule List

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Schedule List, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.



Press the **YELLOW** button to enter the interface below.

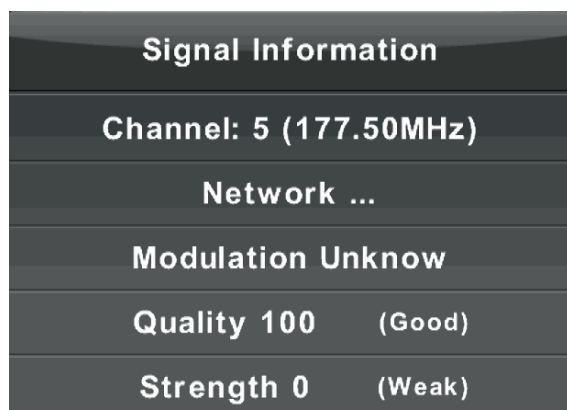


If there is a timing conflict with another programme it will produce a warning message.



Signal Information

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Signal Information**, press the **OK** button to see the detailed information about the signal (only available when there is signal in DTV).

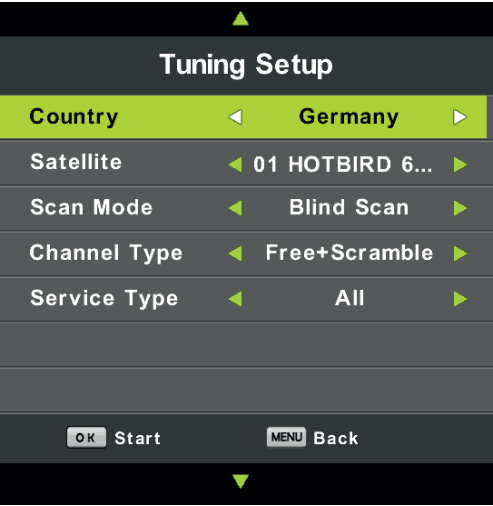

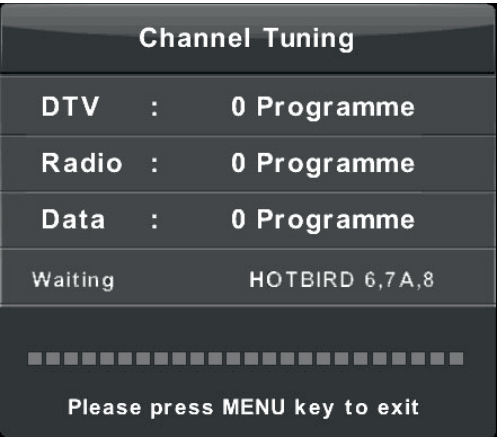
Auto Tuning

Press ▾ / ▴ button to select Auto Tuning, then press **OK** button to enter.



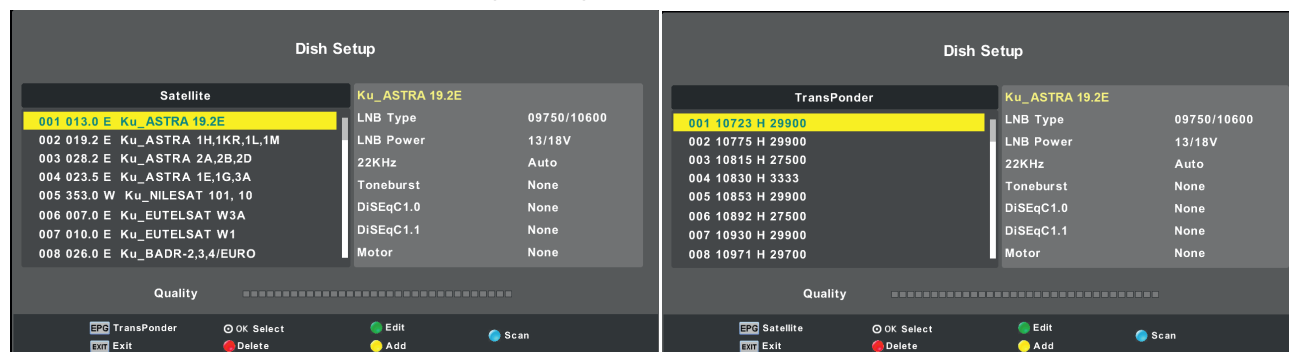
Press MENU button to bring up the main menu. Highlight “Channel” using navigation buttons and press OK. Then highlight “Auto Tuning” and press OK to enter.

- Country:** Select your country.
- Satellite:** Select an available satellite.
- Scan Mode:** Select your scan mode.
- Channel Type:** Select a channel type.
- Service Type:** Select a service type.



Dish Setup

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Dish Setup, then press **OK** button to enter.



Press MENU button to call out the main menu.

Highlight “Channel” using navigation buttons and press OK to enter it.

Then highlight “Dish Setup” and press OK to enter it.

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to highlight Left, Middle or Right column.

Press EXIT button to return.

A. When the “Satellite” column is highlighted:

(1) Press **YELLOW** button to enter Add menu.

Satellite Name

Press RIGHT navigation button to enter rename page.

Use navigation buttons to complete a new name.

Longitude Direction

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select desired option.

Longitude Angle

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to move the cursor and press number buttons on remote control to input desired value.

Band

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select desired option.

(2) Press **GREEN** button on remote control to enter Edit menu.

The operations of Edit menu are the same as Add menu.

(3) Press **BLUE** button on remote control to enter Scan menu.

Press UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight desired item.

Press RIGHT navigation button to select desired Scan Mode, Channel Type and Service Type.

(4) Press **RED** button to delete.

Press **EPG** button to switch satellite and Transponder.

B. When the “Transponder” (Middle) column is highlighted:

(1) Press **YELLOW** button on remote control to enter Add menu.

Frequency

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to move the cursor and press number buttons on remote control to input desired value.

Symbol (ks/s)

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to move the cursor and press number buttons on remote control to input desired value.

Polarity

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select desired option

(2) Press **GREEN** button on remote control to enter Edit menu

The operations of Edit menu are the same with Add menu.

(3) Press **BLUE** button on remote control to enter Scan menu.

Press UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight desired item.

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select desired Scan Mode, Channel Type and Service Type..

Auto Tuning/ATV Manual Tuning /DTV Manual Tuning/Programme edit menus are the same as as the menus in DTV.

Picture Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **PICTURE** in the main menu.



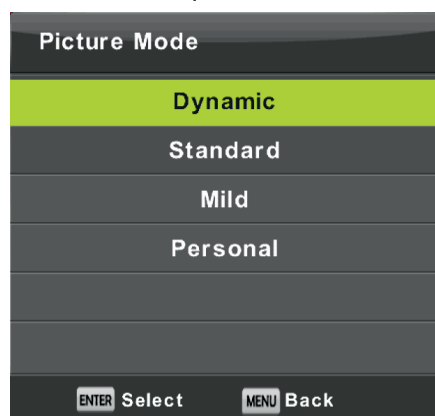
1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **PICTURE** menu.
2. Press **OK** button to adjust.
3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **MENU** button to save and return back to the previous menu.

Picture Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Picture Mode, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

You can change the value of contrast, brightness, color, sharpness and tint when the picture is in **Personal** mode.

TIPS: You can press PMODE button to change the Picture Mode directly.



Contrast/ Brightness/ Color/ Tint / Sharpness

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, then press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

- Contrast** Adjust the highlight intensity of the picture, but the shadow of the picture is invariable.
- Brightness** Adjust the optical fiber output of the entire picture, it will effect the dark region of the picture.
- Colour** Adjust the saturation of the colour based on your own like.
- Tint** Use in compensating color changed with the transmission in the NTSC code.
- Sharpness** Adjust the peaking in the detail of the picture.

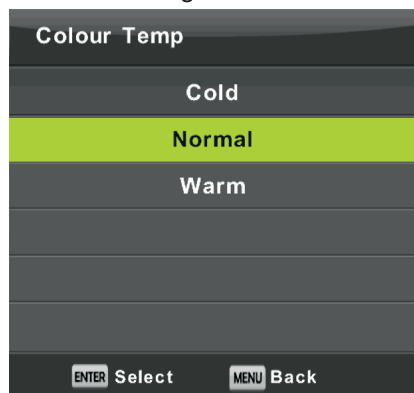
Color Temp

Change the overall color cast of the picture.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Colour Temperature , then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select. (Available Picture mode: Cool, Medium, Warm).

You can change the value of red, green and blue when the color temperature is in **User** mode.



Cold Increase the blue tone for the white.

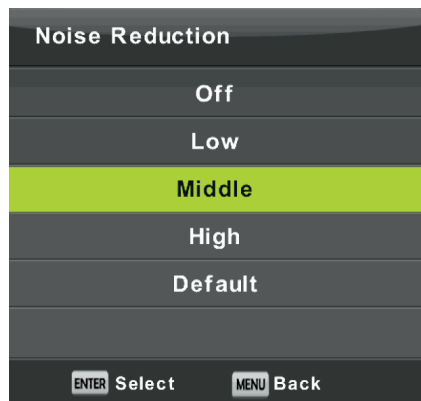
Normal Increase the sex-linked colors for the white.

Warm Increase the red color for the white.

Noise Reduction

To filter out and reduces the image noise and improve picture quality.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Noise Reduction , then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.



Off Select to turn off video noise detection.

Low Detect and reduce low video noise.

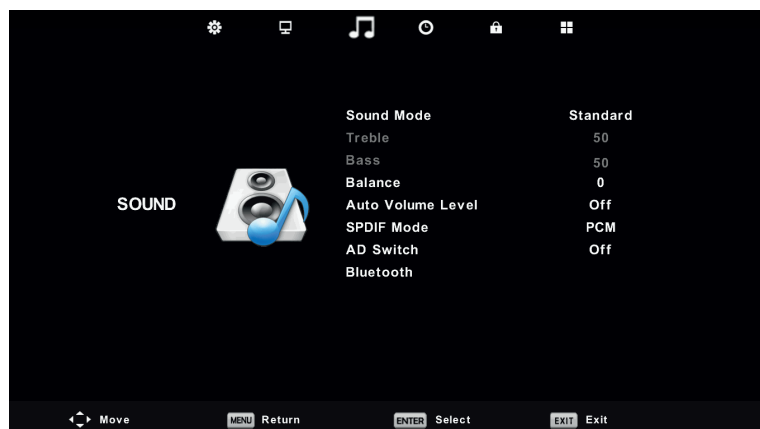
Middle Detect and reduce moderate video noise.

High Detect and reduce enhanced video noise.

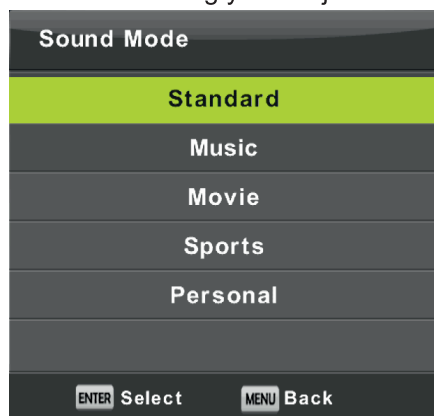
Default Set as Default.

Sound Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SOUND** in the main menu.



1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **SOUND** menu.
2. Press **OK** button to adjust.
3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **Enter** button to save and return to the previous menu.



Sound Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Sound Mode, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select.

You can change the value of Treble and Bass when the sound is in Personal mode.
TIPS: You can press **S.MODE** button on the remote control to change the Sound Mode directly.

Standard	Produces a balanced sound in all environments.
Music	Preserves the original sound. Good for musical programs.
Movie	Enhances treble and bass for a rich sound experience.
Sports	Enhances vocals for sports.
Personal	Select to customize picture settings.

Note: The treble and bass are only available in **User** mode.

Balance

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Auto Volume level

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Auto Volume Level, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

SPDIF Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select SPDIF Mode, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off / PCM / Auto.

AD Switch

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select AD Switch, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.
Amblyopia function for the blind, the tracks will be mixed describe the current screen.

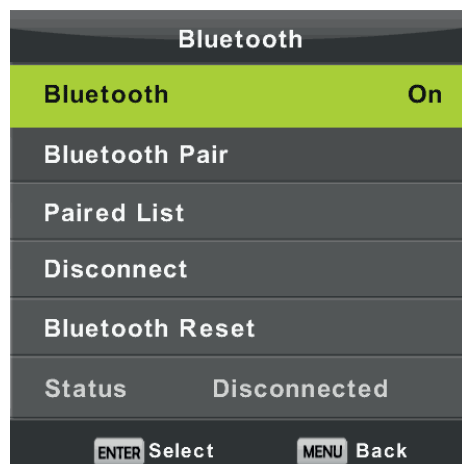
Balance: This item can adjust the speaker's output, it enables you to listen to best at your position.

Auto Volume: This item is used for reducing the difference between channel and program's volume automatically.

Bluetooth

The Bluetooth function allows you to play the audio from the TV through a Bluetooth audio device such as a soundbar, speaker or headphones.

Select Bluetooth from the Sound menu to bring up the Bluetooth sub-menu:



Turning on Bluetooth

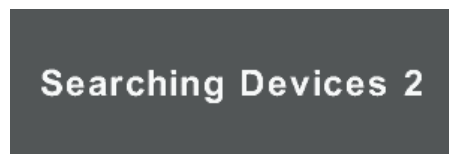
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Bluetooth and press the **OK** button to turn Bluetooth on if it is turned off.

Pairing a new device

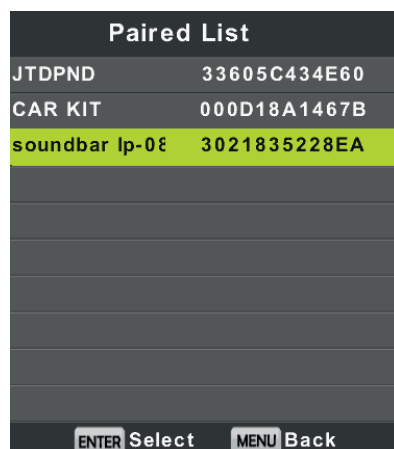
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Bluetooth Pair and press the **OK** button.

The TV will start to search for nearby Bluetooth audio devices, make sure your speaker or headphones are turned on and discoverable.

While the TV is searching you will see a “Searching Devices” message with a count of the number of devices that have been found.



When searching is complete you will see a list of the devices found, press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select the device you want to use and press the **OK** button to connect to the device.



Disconnecting a Bluetooth device

To disconnect a Bluetooth device you can turn the device off and the TV will automatically switch the sound back to the TV after a few seconds.

You can also disconnect the device from the TV as follows:

Press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select Disconnect and press the **OK** button.

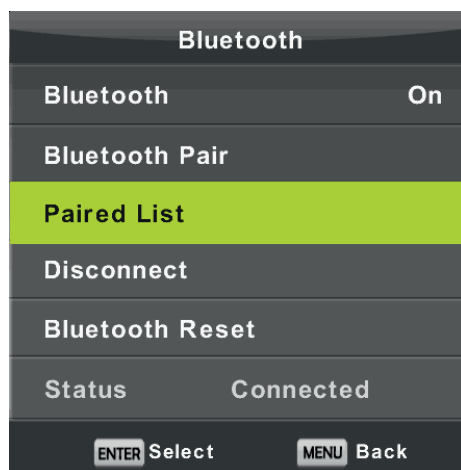
The currently connected device will be disconnected and the sound will be played via the TV.

Reconnecting a device

If you have previously searched for a Bluetooth device you can reconnect to it by selecting it from the Paired List.

Press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select Paired List and press the **OK** button.

Press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select the device you want to use and press the **OK** button to connect to the device.



Bluetooth Reset

To reset the Bluetooth settings and delete all discovered devices:

Press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select Bluetooth Reset and press the **OK** button.

Time Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.

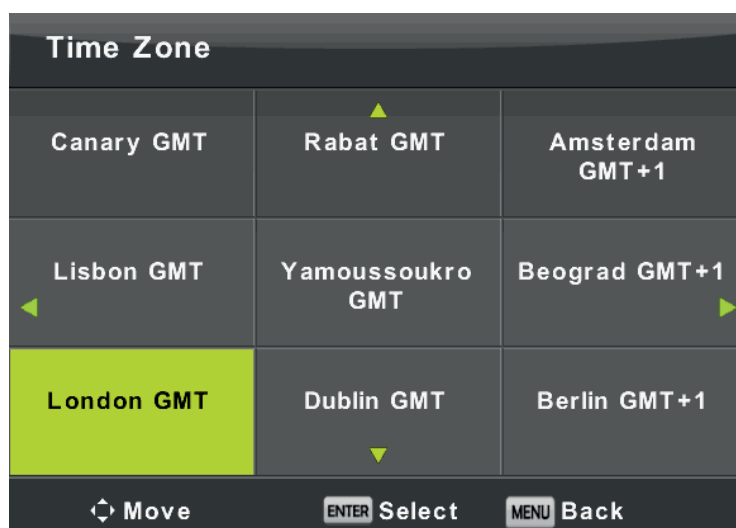
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **TIME** in the main menu.

3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **OK** button to save and return to the previous menu.

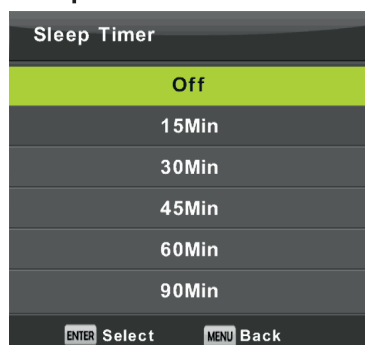

Hotel Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Hotel Mode, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select on or off.

Source Lock

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Source Lock, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu to select.

Default Source

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Default Source, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu to select.

Default Prog

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Default Prog, then press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

It is available when the default source is TV.

Max Volume

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Max Volume, then press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Import Database

We can import parameter of Audio/Channel/Lock/Setup from USB disk. Insert USB disk, choose "Import Database" and press enter to import.

Export Database

We can export parameter of Audio/Channel/Lock/Setup to USB disk. Insert USB disk, choose "Export Database" and press Enter to Export.

Clear Lock

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Clear Lock, then press **OK** button to clear the setting you have done before.

Setup Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SETUP** in the main menu.

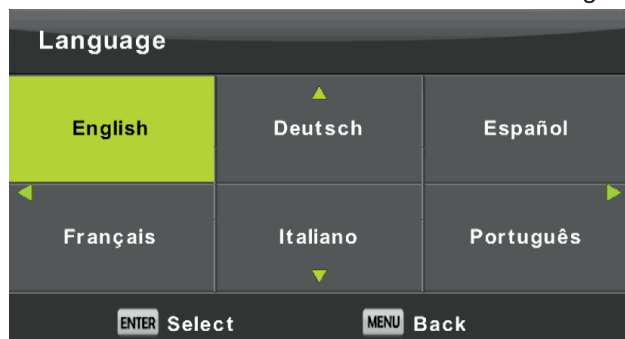

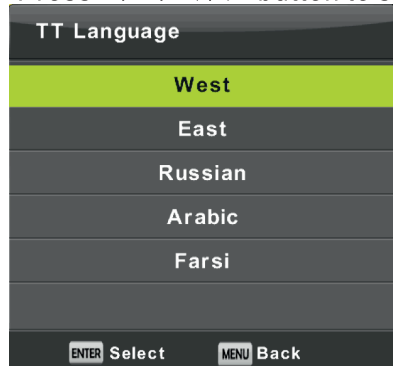

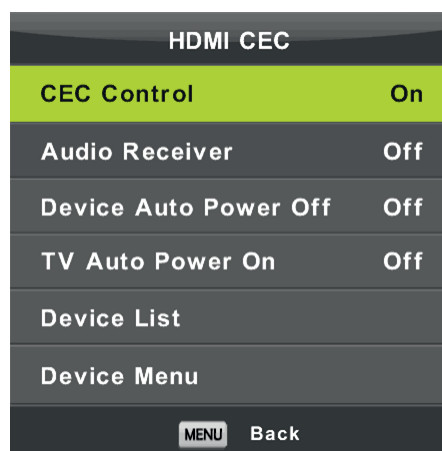

TV Auto Power On

Press ◀ / ▶ button to turn the TV Auto Power On on or off.

Device List

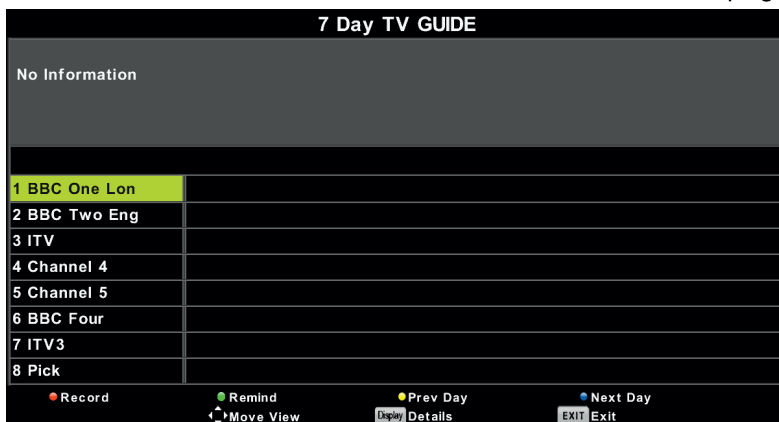
Press **OK** button to show list of device.

Device Menu

Press **OK** button to enter the menu of device.

EPG

Press EPG button on remote control to enter EPG menu page.



Press UP/DOWN navigation button to select preferred program.
Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to switch between left column and right column.

When a program is highlighted (cursor moved to Right column):

Press **RED** button to record program.

Press **GREEN** button repeatedly to set a reminder.

Press **YELLOW** button to display program guide of previous day.

Press **BLUE** button to display program guide of next day.

FAVORITE LIST

When viewing an available channel, press FAV button on remote control to enter Favorite List menu page.

Press UP or DOWN navigation buttons to select preferred channel.

Press OK button to confirm the selection.

NOTE:

To add a favorite channel, please refer to the operations of "DTV Mode > Channel > Programme Edit"



Quick select

When viewing an available channel, press OK button on remote control to enter Channel List menu page.

Press UP or DOWN navigation buttons to select preferred channel.

Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to select a channel group.

Press OK button to confirm the selection.



PC Mode Screen Menu

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SCREEN** in the main menu.



1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **SCREEN** menu.
2. Press **OK** button to adjust.
3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **OK** button to save and return to the previous menu.

Auto Adjust

Press **Enter** button to start adjusting **H-Offset/V-Offset/Size/Phase** automatically.

H-Offset.

Adjust the horizontal position of the picture.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **H-Offset**, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

V-Offset

Adjust the vertical position of the picture.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **V-Offset**, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

Size

Adjust the display size.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Size**, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

Phase

Adjust the horizontal interfering lines.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Phase**, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

Position Reset

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Position Reset**, then press **OK** button to enter.

Notes:

1. Noise Reduction in PICTURE option is invalid.
2. AD Switch in SOUND option is invalid.
3. TIME menu and description are the same as that for Air mode.
4. Block Program and Parental Guidance in LOCK option is invalid.
5. Audio Languages, Subtitle Language, Hearing Impaired and PVR File System in SETUP option is invalid.
6. PC mode has no CHANNEL menu.

Media Operation

Note: Before operating **Media** menu, Plug in USB device, then press INPUT button to set the Input Source to **Media** .
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Media** in the Source menu, then press **OK** button to enter.

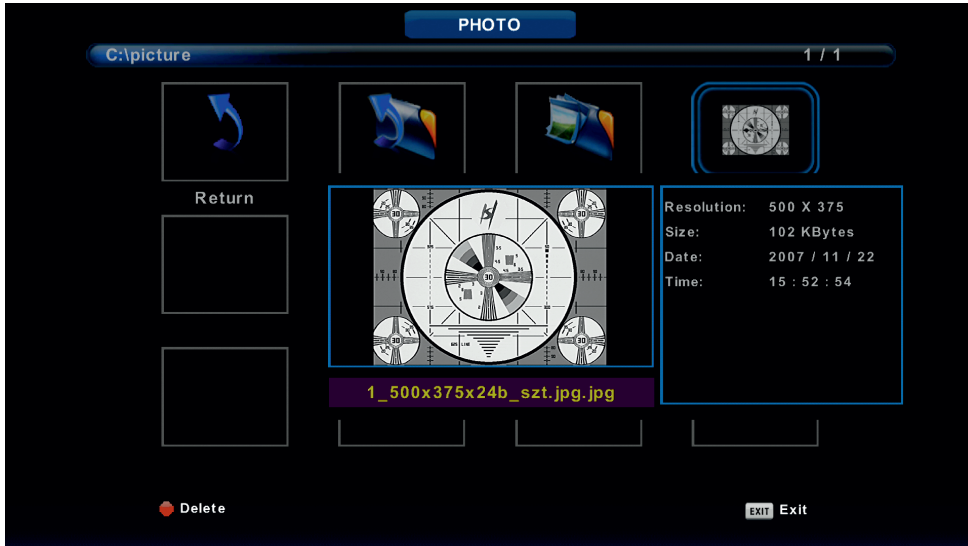

Some DVD discs have been authored in 4:3 aspect ratio format. To see the material in its original mode, you may need to change the Aspect ratio.

Pan & Scan (4 : 3)

Black edges left and right will be seen.

Letterbox (4 : 3)

Top and bottom of the screen may be black.

Wide 16:9 (Widescreen)

Full width picture but may have black areas top and bottom.

OSD Language.

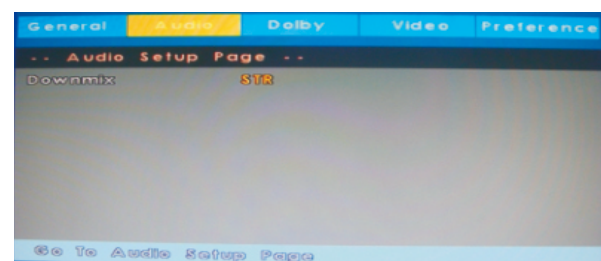
Select the OSD Language (English is default).

Last Memory. ON/OFF.

You may wish the player to remember where it finished playing a disc and then remove the disc. When you stop the disc, the player will automatically remember the point it finished playing. When the disc is re inserted the player will continue from the same point.

2. Audio Setup

When the DVD menu displayed, the DVD system will auto pause. Press SETUP again, it will go on



A. Press SETUP button on remote control during playing DVD, Press "► / ◄" until it will show following menu.

B. Press "▼ / ▲" to choose the items, then enter the desired item with OK button. It has been set already when the desired item becomes red.

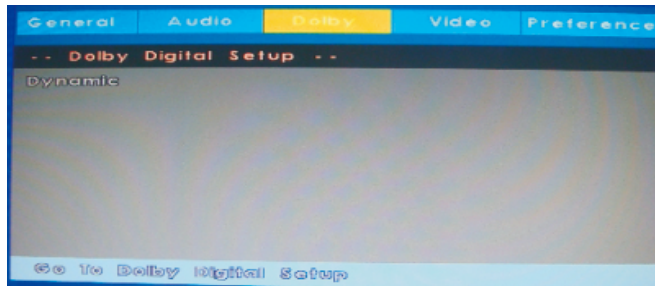
Note: Press Left button to get back the previous menu.

C. Press SETUP to exit the menu.

D. The items of the menu as below.

Downmix: choose the downmix mode. There is only one item--stereo.

3. Dolby Setup



Dynamic is the difference between the maximum level and the minimum level of sounds. this function is generally used when playing high volume programs at night, in order not to disturb the neighbour. This setting can dynamo lower the volume and still keep the original tone quality. This is the range, measured in decibels(dB), between the loudest and the quietest sound registers in a soundtrack.

5. Video Setup



- 1). **sharpness** :
adjust the sharpness of the image.
- 2). **Brightness** :
Select 'Brightness' by using the "▼/▲" button, then press **ENTER**. You can adjust the Brightness by pressing the "◀/▶" button. To exit 'Brightness' setting, press **ENTER** again to return.
- 3). **Contrast** :
Select 'Contrast' by using the "▼/▲" button, then press **ENTER**. You can adjust the Contrast by pressing the "◀/▶" button. To exit 'Contrast' Setting, press **ENTER** again to return.

6. Preference Setup



1.TV Type

TV Type:select the colour type from PAL、 AUTO or NTSC.

2.Audio

Please select the preferred language for DVD audio.

- 1) The selected language is assigned high priority and can therefore be adopted automatically when the player begins playing a disc.
- 2) Languages vary between discs,depending on the DVD.You can also select alternative languages by pressing the AUDIO button on the remote

3.Subtitle

Selects the preferred language for subtitles recorded on Discs.

- 1) The selected subtitle language is assigned high priority and can therefore be adopted automatically when the player begins playing a disc.
- 2) Subtitles vary between discs, depending on the Discs. You can also select alternative subtitle language by pressing the SUBTITLE button on the remote .

4.Disc Menu:

Select the preferred language for the discmenu recorded on the Discs. This choice varies between Discs.

5.Parental

It is possible to restrict playback of certain Discs to a certain level of user, based on their age, for example. Certain scenes can be blocked or replaced with different scenes. The "Parental Control" function lets you set the access control level. This function is password-protected.

Note: If you play discs that do not support the Parental Control function, the DVD player cannot restrict access to the disc.

6.Password

Change the password to your desired .The default password is 0000 .

7.Default

Restore the DVD player's system to factory default settings.

Troubleshooting

PROBLEM

SOLUTION

No picture or sound

Check the power supply is plugged in and turned on.

Picture is OK but no sound

Make sure the volume is not set to minimum or mute. Turn off the TV and turn back on.

Remote control doesn't work

Check the battery connection is correct. Check the batteries. Make sure no obstacles are between the sensor of the remote and TV

No TV Signal

Check the source is set to ATV or DTV. Check the antenna signal status.

No external video signal

Check the source is set to AV

Picture lacks colour or is too dark

Check colour, brightness and contrast settings

All channels lose colour intermittently

Check the antenna in case it is broken, disconnected or damaged.

Poor reception, loss of colour

Check channel is tuned correctly

Diagonal stripes on picture

Receiver may be affected by interference. e.g. nearby radio broadcasting transmitter or from another TV receiver.

Ghost images appear

Antenna direction may have been changed by a storm or strong wind. Ghost images are caused from both the signal travelling directly from the transmitter and a signal reflected from a hill or large building. Direction of the antenna should be chosen to avoid this situation.

USB media files don't work

FAT 32 formatted flash drive required. Reformat if required.

Time Shift and PVR don't work

FAT 32 formatted flash drive required. Reformat if required.
