

The LED TV should be kept free from rain, moisture and dust to prevent electrical shock and short circuits.

Do not cover the ventilation openings with table clothes, curtains, newspapers, etc.

The LED TV should be kept from high temperature heating sources or direct sunlight. Good ventilation is required.

Allow 10 cm. between the LED MONITOR and other appliances or built-in cabinet walls.





When you wipe the front cabinet, please make sure the power plug is pulled out and use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth and handle it with care. Do not repeatedly wipe the panel, nor scrape, tap or strike the panel with a hard object.

Do not wipe the LED TV with any petrol, chemical or alcohol based solvents as it will lead to product damage of the panel and cabinet.





When the television receiver is not used for an extended period of time, it is advisable to disconnect the AC power cord from the AC outlet.


Important Safety Precautions

Do not place the LED TV on an unstable surface.

Do not place the power cord or other cables across a walkway in case it is trampled on. Do not overload the power cord or power socket. When the power plug is used to disconnect and connect the device, it should easily go into the power source.





Do not disassemble the back cover, as it contains high voltages inside and will cause electric shock. Only qualified professionals should conduct internal adjustments, maintenance, and checks.

The TV set should not be subjected to water droplets, vapor, or splashes. This equipment should not be placed on objects filled with liquids. Do not place flame sources, such as lit candles, on or near the LED TV. Please, pull out the power plug and contact after sales support if there are abnormal objects or water in the TV.






Pull out the power cord and antenna cable during electrical storms so the LED TV is not damaged by electrical surges. Keep all people away from the antenna cable during electrical storms.








TV Controls


- VOL(+) This button increases the TV's volume. If the OSD menu is active, pressing this button will
 move the selection to the right.
- VOL(-) This button decreases the TV's volume. If the On Screen Display(OSD) menu is active, pressing this button will move the selection to the left.
- 3. CH(+) This button performs the channel up function. If the OSD menu is active, this button functions as up control for the menu.
- 4. CH(-) This button performs the channel down function. If the OSD menu is active, this button functions as down control for the menu.
- MENU This button activates the OSD menu. If a sub-menu is active, pressing this button will return the selection to the previous menu level.
- SOURCE This button switches between all the different sources of the TV. When the OSD is active, this button acts as the enter button and confirms the menu selection.
- 7. ►II After you load a disc, press ►II to play the disc, and press ►II twice to pause.
- 9. POWER(ϕ) Turn on the TV by pressing the button once. Press the button again to turn off the TV.

Installation

Wall-mounting

This television set is equipped with VESA mounting points on the back panel for use with wall-mounting brackets (not included).

NOTE: The distance between the holes is 100 x 100 mm in width and height.



For wall-mounting, remove the four screws to remove the entire stand assembly.

NOTE: The screws in the package are for securing the TV stand only. If you are wall-mounting the TV, use the screws supplied with the wall mount.






Illustration of the Connections






Note

- The battery (battery or batteries or battery pack) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.


Antenna connection

Antenna input impedance of this unit is 75ohm. VHF/UHF 75ohm coaxial cable can be connected to the antenna jack directly, if the antenna cable is 300ohm parallel flat feeder cable, you need to use the 300ohm/75ohm converter to connect the antenna cable to the antenna jack. Press OK button to select specific submenu and the adjustable value.
In the submenu, press ▼/▲ or button to select menu item.



Press MENU button to display the MAIN OSD MENU.

Press **▼**/**▲** button to select the MENU you want.

Press ENTER button or ▶ button to enter the sub menu, and press ◀ button to return back to the previous menu.

Press ▼/▲ button to select the option and then press ENTER button or ▶ button to enter the submenu, press ◀/▶ button to adjust the value or press ▼/▲ button to selec in the sub menu. You only can change the value of brightness, contrast, sharpness, color, when the picture is in User mode.

TIPS: You can press P-MODE button on the remoter control again and again to change the picture mode directly.

Sharpness

Sound Mode

Press ▲/▼ button to select Sound Mode, and then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter. And then press ▲/▼ button to select. (Available Sound mode: Bass, Treble, EQ, Balance).

You can change the value of bass and treble, Balance and EQ, when the sound is in User mode.

TIPS: You can press S-MODE button on the remote control to change the Sound Mode directly.



Press GREEN button to set the current channel to delete, if the current channel already delete, press GREEN button again will cancel delete.

Press YELLOW button to skip the current channel, if the current channel already skip, press YELLOW button again will cancel skip.


Press BLUE button to swap the channel position.

If one of the channel has been incorrectly placed in the station listing, you may move it to the current position you want using the $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ select the channel to be moved, press BULE button, move the channel to the new location and press ENTER button or BLUE button, this will move the station to the new location.

If there is delete channel logo press MENU button or ENTER button, the menu will appear as follows:



Press ◀ button to choose OK, press ▶ button choose cancel, press ENTER to confirm.

Press RED button to enter a space.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Channel, press GREEN button to set to Fav2.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Channel, press YELLOW button to set to Fav3.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Channel, press BLUE button to set to Fav4.

If the current channel already be one of your favorite channel, press the RED/ GREEN/ YELLOW/ BLUE button again will set it to a normal channel.

Press MENU button or EXIT button, the successfully updated menu will appear.

Press ENTER button or ▶ button to enter, then Press ▲/▼ button to select appropriate country, and press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

TV Connection

Press ENTER button or ▶ button to enter, then Press ▲/▼ button to select TV Connection (Antenna, DVB-S2), and press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

Auto Search

Press ▲/▼ button to select Auto Search, then press ENTER or ► button to enter (When the System Lock is on, please input the default password "0000").



OSD Menu Operations

Press ▲/▼ button to select All, Digital, Analogue, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter



Auto Search selected items if select "OK" and press ENTER, other wise select CANCEL to return back to previous page. After a few second, the menu will appear as follows:



Press ▲/▼ button to select Fine Tune, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter, the menu will appear as follows:

Press ▲/▼ button to select Color System, then press ENTER or ▶ to enter the sub menu.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Auto/PAL/SECAM, then press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm. Sound System

Press ▲/▼ button to select Sound System, and press ENTER or ▶ to enter the sub menu,

Press MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Feature in the main menu, then press ENTER or ▶ to enter.

Child Lock

Press ▲/▼ button to select Child Lock, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter. (Please input the default password "0000")



Child Channel

Press \triangle/∇ button to select Child Channel, then press $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ key to select off or on. Then press ENTER or \triangleright button to confirm.

Parental Lock

Press ▲/▼ button to select Parental Rating, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter the sub menu. Then press ▲/▼ button to select Rate (From4-18, or OFF).

Then press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

Change Pin Code

Press ▲/▼ button to select Change Pin Code, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter and Change Pin Code menu will appear as follows:



Input old password at "Old Password", (if the old password is incorrect, the password will not be allowed to modify.)

Input new password at "New Password".

Input new password again at "Confirm New Password", if new password and confirm new password consistent, the successfully updated menu will appear a few second, otherwise, the menu will display the password mismatch.

Digital Teletext Language

Press \triangle/∇ button to select Digital Teletext language, then press ENTER or \triangleright button to enter the sub menu. Then Press \triangle/∇ button to select, then press ENTER or \triangleright button to confirm.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Analog Teletext language, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter the sub menu, Then Press ▲/▼ button to select, then press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

Press \triangle/∇ button to select Auto Power Off, then press ENTER or \triangleright button to enter the sub menu, Then Press \triangle/∇ button to select, then press ENTER or \triangleright button to confirm.

Setup Menu

Press MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ▲/▼ button to select Setup in the main menu, then press ENTER or ▶ to enter.



- 1. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the Setup menu, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter.
- 2. Press **◄/**▶ button to adjust or press **▲/**▼button to select.
- 3. After finishing your adjustment, press MENU button to save and return back to the previous menu and press EXIT button to exit the entire menu.

OSD Timer

Press ▲/▼ button to select OSD Timer, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter the sub menu, Then Press ▲/▼ button to select. (Available OSD Timer:5 Second, 10 Second, 15 Second, 20 Second, 25 Second, 30 Second, never), then press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

Auto SCART

Press ▲/▼ button to select Auto SCART, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter the sub menu, Then Press ▶ button to select ON or Off, then press ENTER or ▶ button to confirm.

Picture defects and the reason



Snowy Picture

Snowy picture is usually due to weak signal. Adjust antenna or install an antenna amplifier.



Double Image or Ghosts

Double images are usually caused by reflections from tall buildings. Adjust the direction of the antenna or raise it.



Radio Wave Interference

Wave patterns are moving on the screen, which are usually caused by nearby radio transmitters or shortwave receiving equipment.



High Temperature Electrothermal Interference

Diagonal or herringbone patterns appear on the screen or part of picture is missing. This is probably caused by high temperature electrothermal equipment in a nearby hospital.
